

Rare breeding birds in the United Kingdom in 2008

The following updates to the published species accounts reflect additional data and corrections received after publication of the 2008 RBBP report in *British Birds* 103:482-538 (September 2010). This update includes all known amendments up to **15th December 2017**.

Garganey *Anas querquedula*

Revised totals: 66 sites: 21-103 pairs.

Lothian One site: one pair possibly bred.

Co. Antrim One site: one pair bred; a pair in May and at least one juvenile reported in July.

Greater Scaup *Aythya marila*

Revised totals: Three sites: 0-3 pairs.

Common Goldeneye *Bucephala clangula*

Revised totals: At least 183 egg-laying females, including one in England.

From the additional data provided by the Goldeneye Study Group for Highland, coupled with the data already published for North-east Scotland, an estimate of 182 egg-laying females was derived.

Highland Badenoch & Strathspey: in 83 monitored nests, 71 clutches were incubated and from these 441 eggs hatched in 57 nests. The mean brood size was 7.7 young.

Golden Oriole Oriolus oriolus

Revised totals: Five sites: 2–9 pairs.

West Midlands One site: a singing male heard and a female seen in suitable breeding habitat on 3rd June only.

Red-backed Shrike *Lanius collurio*

Revised totals: Four sites: five unpaired males and one other single birds.

Sussex One site: a singing male in suitable breeding habitat was reported between 24th May and 19th June.

Cetti's Warbler *Cettia cetti*

Revised totals: 2,255 singing males or territories.

Dartford Warbler *Sylvia undata*

Revised totals: 2,110 territories.

Berkshire at least 37 territories.

Marsh Warbler *Acrocephalus palustris*

Revised totals: Eight sites: 2-10 pairs.

Fair Isle One site: one singing male present from 1st to 23rd July.

Melodious Warbler *Hippolais polyglotta*

Amended dates as follows:

Lancashire & N Merseyside The singing male was present from 7th to 21st June (not May).

Brambling *Fringilla montifringilla*

Revised totals: Two sites: 0-2 pairs.

Kent One site: one singing male present from mid April to at least 18th May with a female present on three dates between 26th April and 11th May.
