Rare breeding birds in the United Kingdom in 2009

The following updates to the published species accounts reflect additional data and corrections received after publication of the 2009 RBBP report in *British Birds* 104:476-537 (September 2011). This update includes all known amendments up to 5th February 2016.

Whooper Swan *Cygnus cygnus* Revised totals: 17 sites: 13-18 pairs.

Additional record: Scotland, N & W Outer Hebrides One additional site: one pair bred, hatching six and fledging five young.

Shoveler Anas clypeata

Revised totals: 317-1,103 pairs.

Amended county totals as follows: Scotland, N & W Outer Hebrides Confirmed breeding pairs: 4; Total pairs: 25.

Cattle Egret Bubulcus ibis

Revised totals: Four sites: 0-4 pairs.

Additional record: England, SW Dorset One site: two adults visited a heronry in April and May but did not breed.

Black-necked Grebe Podiceps nigricollis

Revised totals: 21 sites: 31-54 pairs, at least 52 young fledged.

Upgraded details: England, C Staffordshire One site: one pair bred; but failed owing to disturbance.

Red Kite Milvus milvus

Revised total: a minimum of 1,095 pairs.

Amended county totals as follows: Scotland, Mid Upper Forth (Central Scotland RSG) Confirmed and probable breeding pairs: 28.

Marsh Harrier Circus aeruginosus

Revised totals: 363-408 breeding females/pairs.

Hen Harrier Circus cyaneus

Revised totals: 165-179 pairs. At least 275 young fledged.

Peregrine Falcon Falco peregrinus

Revised totals: 820-1,026 pairs monitored.

Water Rail Rallus aquaticus

Revised totals: 361 sites: a minimum of 1,178 territories; 166 pairs confirmed breeding.

Amended county totals as follows: Scotland, S Borders 18 sites, 31 territories.

Little Ringed Plover Charadrius dubius

Revised totals: 600 pairs.

Amended county totals as follows: Wales Anglesey The record of a confirmed breeding pair in Anglesey should be deleted.

Ruff Calidris pugnax

Revised totals: three sites: three females.

Additional record: Scotland, N & W Outer Hebrides One site: one bird present in late May and a female still on territory on 21st June.

Little Gull Hydrocoloeus minutus

The published RBBP report for 2009 did not include any records of this species.

Two sites: two pairs probably bred. A pair attempted to breed in Norfolk in 2007, but was unsuccessful.

England, E

Norfolk One site: one pair probably bred: the birds were displaying and holding territory in a Black-headed Gull *Chroicocephalus ridibundus* colony from 21st to 27th May. England, N

Yorkshire One site: up to three second-summer birds present from 8th to 13th June, with two remaining until 16th June. Display and collection of nest material was noted, with one bird also seen apparently sitting on a nest.

Mediterranean Gull Larus melanocephalus

Correction to text; no change to published totals.

England, N Yorkshire One site: one pair probably bred and one pair possibly bred. Wales Carmarthenshire The one breeding pair constitutes the first confirmed br

Carmarthenshire The one breeding pair constitutes the first confirmed breeding of this species in Wales.

Little Tern Sternula albifrons

Revised totals: 65 sites: 1,569 pairs confirmed breeding.

Amended county totals as follows: Scotland, N & W Argyll 12 sites, 67 confirmed breeding pairs.

Wryneck Jynx torquilla

Revised totals: Four sites: 0-4 pairs.

Additional record: England, SE Essex One site: one male singing in suitable habitat, indeed a former breeding site, on 25th May only.

Iberian Chiffchaff Phylloscopus ibericus

The published RBBP report for 2009 did not include any records of this species.

One site: one singing male. With the addition of this record, and the belated acceptance (by BBRC) of a singing bird in Cheshire & Wirral in 2004, the Panel now has records of this species from eight of the last 11 years, since the first in 1999.

England, SW

Hampshire One site: one singing male heard from 10th to 17th May.

Savi's Warbler Locustella lusciniodes

Correction to text (dates only); no change to published totals.

England, SE

Greater London/Essex One site: one singing male 30th April to 30th May.

Marsh Warbler Acrocephalus palustris

Revised totals: 13 sites: 5-16 pairs.

Additional record: England, N Co. Durham One site: two singing males, one from 15th to 24th June, second bird 20th to 21st June. A third bird, possibly a female, also present.

Greater Scaup Aythya marila There were also at least 28 birds on Lough Neagh in Northern Ireland on the late date of 21st May.
